


INTRODUCTION

Rashtrapati Nilayam serves as the esteemed official winter residence of the Honorable President of India, situated in Hyderabad, Telangana. This distinguished retreat is traditionally host to the President during the annual sojourn known as the Winter Visit, customarily occurring in December.

Comprising 97 acres, Rashtrapati Nilayam is spread across three contiguous estates within the tranquil precincts of the Secunderabad Cantonment in Bollarum Village. Over the years, through successive presidencies, the estate has been meticulously curated to include verdant, themed gardens that are a testament to the natural splendor and the rich cultural tapestry of India. Each corner of the campus is steeped in history and heritage, offering a serene and stately repose from the presidential duties.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE RASHTRAPATI NILAYAM

The origins of the Rashtrapati Nilayam, an estate of considerable historical significance can be traced back to the year 1860. Built as the Residency House for the representatives of the British Crown, it subsequently became the residence of the Chief Military Officer of the Nizam, the erstwhile ruler of Hyderabad.

This estate was witness to a turning point in the making of Modern India— the accession of the Princely State of Hyderabad into the Indian Union on the 17th of September, 1948. Following this historic merger, the estate was designated as the winter sojourn for the President of India, and was named Rashtrapati Nilayam. The tradition of the winter visit has been carried forward by successive Presidents who grace the Nilayam with their presence in December every year.

In recognition of its cultural and historical value, the Rashtrapati Nilayam was customarily opened to the public for a fortnight in January subsequent to the presidential visit. During this period, visitors were given the opportunity of going around its immaculately maintained gardens — including the Herbal Garden, Rock Garden, and Nakshatra Vatika. The visitors also enjoyed the view of the stately main building from its windows, thus experiencing the legacy of this historic abode.

REMARKABLE DECISION OF MARCH 2023

In an unprecedented and historic move, President Smt. Droupadi Murmu, upon her ascension to the esteemed office of the President of India, made the visionary decision to open the august Rashtrapati Nilayam to the public, affirming her commitment to fostering a deeper connection with the citizenry of India. It was her foresight to transform this illustrious estate into a dynamic hub of learning, thereby promoting nationalistic fervor and unity amongst the populace.

On the auspicious occasion of Ugadi on the 22nd of March, 2023, President Smt. Droupadi Murmu, through a solemn virtual ceremony, initiated the public's year-round access to Rashtrapati Nilayam in Bolarum, Secunderabad. This magnanimous gesture has been met with resounding approval, with the property attracting over **90,000** visitors globally in the past year.

The formal declaration of this landmark initiative was commemorated with a virtual inauguration event. During this august ceremony, President Smt. Droupadi Murmu had the honor of inaugurating several significant projects: the Knowledge Gallery, an educational museum dedicated to the history of Rashtrapati Bhavan and its presidencies; the Cheriyal Art - Kitchen Tunnel; as well as laying the foundation for the restoration of the Jai Hind Ramp, three historical stepwells, and the construction of a replica of the historic woodenflag post within the Rashtrapati Nilayam premises.

Addressing the nation, the President emphasized that the Rashtrapati Nilayam Retreat is the collective heritage of all Indians. In the spirit of the 'Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav,' she articulated a vision for an enlightened citizenry, conversant with the legacies of our freedom fighters and the ethos of our independence. The Knowledge Gallery, she proclaimed, stands as a testament to this vision, dedicated to illuminating the unsung heroes of India's independence.

The President encouraged individuals, especially the youth, to immerse themselves in the rich tapestry of our nation's legacy through visits to the Nilayam. This initiative marks a transformative period of openness and engagement, inviting individuals from diverse backgrounds to experience the historical and architectural splendors of the estate. The year-round opening of the Nilayam not only enhances tourism but also fosters cultural discourse, offering a glimpse into India's profound historical narrative and advancing a progressive era of heritage preservation and public participation.

PRESIDENTIAL REVIEWS AND STRATEGIC DIRECTION

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE DECEMBER 2023 SOJOURN

The distinguished sojourn of President Smt. Draupadi Murmu in December 2023 was marked by the ceremonial unveiling of new attractions at Rashtrapati Nilayam, enriching the historical and cultural tapestry of the estate.

Flag Post

In a symbolic homage to India's sovereignty, a majestic replica of the historic flag post, where the tricolour was unfurled on 17th September 1948, signifying Hyderabad's integration into the Indian Union, was unveiled by the President. This significant project came to fruition through the concerted efforts of various entities, including the partnership of the Institute of Infrastructure Finance Corporation Limited (IIFCL) with the National Culture Fund, and the expertise of the Archaeological Survey of India and CSIR- Central Building Research Institute, culminating in the execution by National Buildings Construction Corporation Limited.

The aesthetic elevation of the rock garden with the consecration of Shiva and Nandi bull sculptures, situated amidst a serene water cascade, offers visitors a tranquil and contemplative experience.

Three Restored Stepwells

The President also launched the restoration of three historic stepwells: the Jai Hind stepwell, Nakshatra stepwell, and Chinna Baavi. These ancient water structures, now equipped to capture 13 million litres of rainwater annually, serve as living exhibits of traditional water conservation techniques. An interpretation centre, featuring the stepwell museum with displays of historical vessels and photographs, and an audio-visual room narrating the conservation efforts, were inaugurated as well.

Herbal Garden

Inaugurated by President Smt. Pratibha Patel, this aromatic haven was developed in 2010 with support from the National Medicinal Plants Board. It houses 116 varieties of medicinal plants and is renowned for its rare Rudraksha trees and the vivid Sindoor or Lipstick Tree (Bixa orellana).

Fruit Orchards

Spanning 33 acres within the 75-acre main campus, the orchards boast a variety of fruit trees including Mango, Sapodilla (Chikoo), Indian Gooseberry (Amla), Custard Apple, Pomegranate, Guava, Coconut, and venerable Tamarind trees. Initiated by Dr. Abdul Kalam, the orchards have flourished since 2008, now offering a bounty of the finest fruit varieties in the nation.

This grove, a recent addition, is home to species such as Sandalwood, Red Sanders, Rosewood, and other native trees like Peepal and Banyan. The Bambusetum features various species of bamboo, contributing to the biodiversity of the estate.

The conversion of in situ rocks into a Cactus garden and the installation of water cascades, along with the rainwater storage bund adorned with Alamandas, showcase the estate's dedication to soil conservation and aesthetic landscaping.

Nakshatra Vatika

This garden, inaugurated in 2015 by late former President Shri Pranab Mukherjee, is arranged according to astrological constellations, with trees aligned with the zodiac signs, the 27 Nakshatras, and the nine planetary bodies of the solar system. During President Shri Ram Nath Kovind's tenure, the Nilayam's greenery was further enhanced with native species and the natural grandeur of granite outcrops, in alignment with Telangana State's Haritha Haram afforestation initiative.
